

Lawn Bowls Etiquette

(Defined as Acceptable Professional Conduct)

- Do not act in a way to bring your club, or yourself into disrepute
- Do not distract players on the mat
- Do not sit on the edge of the bank
- Do not loiter in the vicinity of the head
- Keep movement at the head to a minimum
- Avoid straying onto adjacent rinks (encroaching)
- Pick up the mat after your opponent has delivered the last bowls in an end
- Always be gracious, and don't blame outside factors for your failure
- When measuring, and removing bowls from the head, ensure that the removed bowls do not go outside your rink
- Hand bowls and/or the jack to one another, when convenient, or desired by your opponent
- Accept results of an end without showing signs of disagreement
- Seconds to check the score with each other after each end
- Always act in a sportsman like manner
